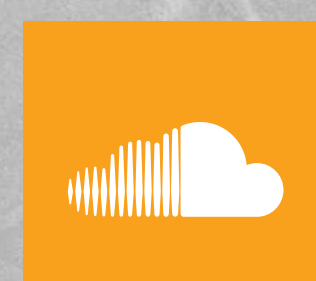
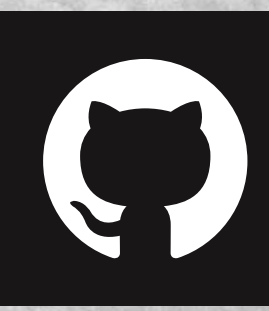

Social Media

Facebook

A family or friend can 'memorialize' or delete a Facebook account:

By specifying a legacy contact, you leave this decision to someone you trust:

Twitter

Currently Twitter will only leave the account of the deceased as is or close it:

Instagram

A birth or death certificate or some other proof is required to memorialize an account:

LinkedIn

A profile can be removed if an obituary is supplied:

Pinterest

An account can only be left as is or deactivated:

Flickr

Unless a family member has your credentials, your Flickr account will eventually revert to free and remain as it is. Flickr has no special provisions in the case of death.

Email

See Google below if you have Gmail. With most email systems, you have little choice but to leave your name password in a secure place but easily found place (such as AfterVault) if you want your family to have access after your death.

Digital Assets

Google

The Inactive Account Manager allows you to specify a period of inactivity after which you can specify the disposition of your individual various accounts (Gmail, Docs, YouTube, Photos, Plus, etc.)

Amazon

Family accounts allow sharing of your eBooks, audiobooks, apps, and games with one other adult in your household. Photos can be shared with up to five with a family vault.

Yahoo

Yahoo allows accounts to be closed and billing suspended with a user id, a death certificate, and proof of executorship. No access to the account will be granted.

Dropbox

You can make it easy by granting access to loved ones. Otherwise, they'll need a court order.

Shutterfly

Shutterfly will grant access to an account when presented with a death certificate and a power-of-attorney.

iTunes/iCloud/EverNote/Snapfish/etc

In many cases, you can't legally bequest digital assets after you die. The only current workaround is to somehow leave your account names and passwords for your beneficiaries. Of course, we don't recommend this. But it would work.

Social Accounts

PayPal

To close a PayPal account, your family will need a death certificate and an executor.

LastPass

An emergency contact can be assigned to your account. This person will be able to request access to your account and will gain access to it if you don't respond in a specified period of time.

An 'emergency kit' can be created and kept in a safe place, such as AfterVault.com, for your family to use in an emergency.
